## BOOK WEEK @ TRUNKEY PS

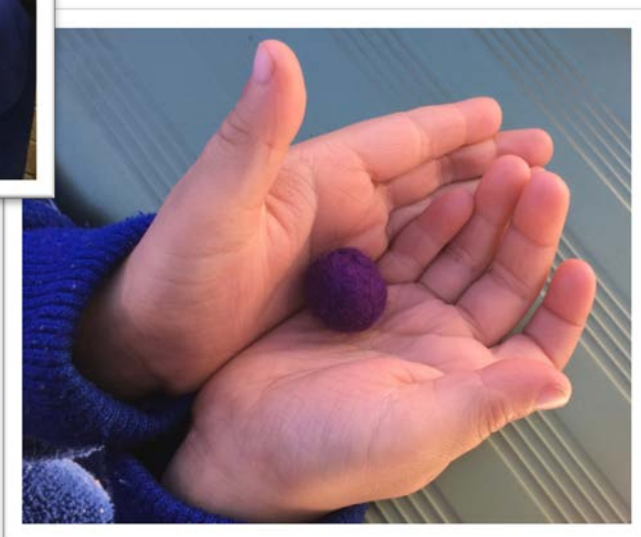
Tomorrow is our annual Book Week celebration at Trunkey Public School where we'll be escaping into the amazing world of books with students from other Heritage small schools.
