

# **NATIONAL SIMULTANEOUS STORYTIME**



On Wednesday 23rd May we took part in the National Simultaneous Story Time. National Simultaneous Story time (NSS) is held annually by the Australian Library and Information Association, where a book is read simultaneously across libraries, schools, pre-schools, childcare centres, family homes, bookshops and many other places around the country. This year, the book was 'Hickory Dickory Dash' by Tony Wilson. Miss Webb read the students the 'new take' nursery rhyme classic at 11am and discussed the story with the students, differences, similarities and all the techniques used in the book.

Across Australia there were 1,062,230 participants across 8,255 locations!
