If I saw her I would take a photo and then run for my life!

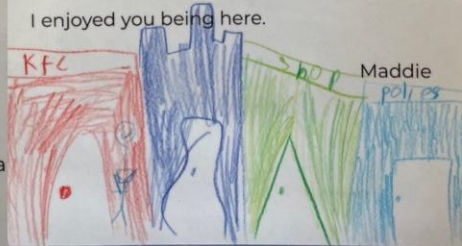
